## Why Conformity Assessment?

- Widespread adoption of IHE Profiles by national, regional and hospital eHealth projects
- Many ehealth projects explicitly leverage Connectathon results in their product tenders/acquisition.
- Projects report un-even compliance to IHE profiles across products and discrepancies between commercial products IHE features and vendor Connectathon results
- Increasing number of national/regional ehealth projects establish their own conformity testing. Expected for project specific extensions, but <u>duplicative for IHE profile</u> conformity.
- → Vendor and ehealth projects interested to avoid duplicative testing of generic IHE Profile conformity




### **IHE Strategy on Conformity Assessment**

- Focus on **Testing** (not certification)
  - → <u>deliver a trusted</u> <u>Fest Report</u>
- Enable countries/projects to require and recognize these Test Reports and perform any additional project specific testing (they may also add a certification process on top of the testing process).
- Ensure international equivalency of Test Reports and recognition of these Test Reports for their trustworthiness:
  - A single process → conformity assessment scheme (IHE-CAS)
  - The same test tooling → provided by IHE International
  - ₩ Test Reports published → by IHE International
- Multiple testing laboratories across the world accredited and authorized by IHE International (competition & convenience)



## **IHE Conformity Assessment for who?**

- 1. The <u>larger eHealth Projects</u> (national, regional, hospital network) that want to engage a broad number of vendors to supply products with IHE profile conformance. Use IHE Conformity Assessment as an entry criteria into procurement and project level lab testing (Projectathon).
- 2. The care delivery organization (e.g. Hospital/Clinic) with simple interoperability projects (e.g. connecting devices to a Clinical System). Only a few profiles to be combined.
- 3. <u>Vendors</u> that want to avoid the overhead of retesting in each project at the profile level.




## **Conformity Assessment Deployment**

#### Operational since April 2015:

- IHE International Board Approved Conformity Assessment Scheme (IHE-CAS-vol. 1) in May 2014.
- Initial Set of Profiles selected by IHE-Europe, IHE-USA and IHE Japan in September 2014: CT, ATNA, PDQ, PDQV3, PIX, XDS.
- Kereval (IHE-Europe) and ICSA Labs (IHE-USA) Authorized.
- First four products tested in April 2015 (positive feedback from vendors on value added) by Kereval as accredited/authorized test laboratory.

## **Organization of Conformity Assessment (1)**

- The test session will be conducted according to the <a href="IHE">IHE</a> International Conformity Assessment Scheme:</a>
  - **❖IHE-CAS-1**
  - **❖IHE-CAS-2**



The test sessions will be conducted in Europe\* by KEREVAL HealthLab, an <u>ISO/CEI 17025 accredited</u> testing laboratory, under supervision of its qualified resources: testing team and test session manager:



<sup>\*</sup> ICSA Labs in the USA will also offer IHE-CA testing sessions for a subset of the profiles



## Rules and commitments for Systems Under Test (SUT)

- Be a marketed released (or about to be released) commercial product
- The vendor shall have passed in the previous 2 years the IHE Connectation for the profile/actors to be conformity assessed.
- The Test Report, valid for two years, will be provided as soon as all the elements of the test session are completed
- If a product is updated with a new released version:
  - The vendor may request an extension of the scope of the report to the testing laboratory. The testing laboratory, upon the analysis of the information communicated by the vendor, will decide if some retesting is required or not.
  - An additional Conformity Assessment report is issued
- The Testing Laboratory is in charge of:
  - Publishing the Conformity Assessment Report on the IHE International Web Site (<a href="http://conformity.ihe.net">http://conformity.ihe.net</a>)
  - Providing the report to the company



## **Fees**

- IHE-Europe has established with Kereval a cost-recovery only fee.
- ❖ For 1 system under test (SUT) and for up to 4 profile/actor pairs : 5500 €
  - ❖Note: the CT/Time Client profile/actor pair is tested for free
- Additional profile/actor pairs for the same system (SUT) may be tested for 1000 € each.



## IHE Conformity Assessment Key points

- Guarantees that an IHE profile implementation in a commercial product is positively tested against an IHE test plan/test tools
- Est Report provided by a trusted neutral organization
- Specific version of a specific product (re-testing may be needed for product evolution) Does not imply that retesting is needed for each product/version (e.g. using same software).
- The process and rigor of "Conformity Assessment" defined in terms of a ISO/IEC 17025 based "IHE Conformity Assessment Scheme - IHE-CAS" (process, test plan and test tools) to ensure quality and world-wide equivalence
- Takes testing **rigor and trust** to the next level above the Connectathon. Expects a vendor to pass appropriate Connectathon tests as a prerequisite for seeking profile/actor conformity assessment.


